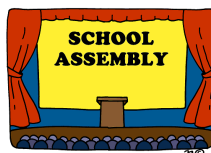

6. **Club Timetable** - Please find attached our clubs timetable for Term 4. There will be no Games Club or Aerobics during Term 4 but they should return later this year.

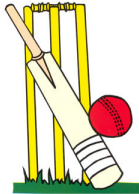
