Please note that all payments and communications for our FOKS team should be put in the FOKS post box in the school reception area.

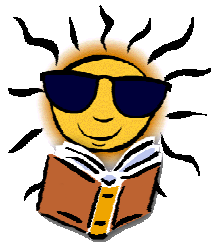
