NOTES FOR PARENTS / GUARDIANS

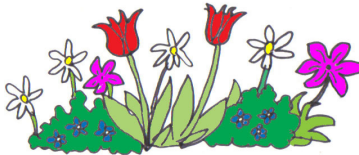
