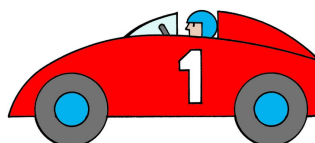
8. **Chess Club** - Unfortunately, due to a lack of interest, we will not be going ahead with Chess Club. We will review again next year.
